Cookies

We use cookies on our website. This is a common website practice. Below you will find information on what cookies we use and how you can delete them or prevent their use.

By continuing to use our website, you agree to their use. If you do not agree with their use, follow the instructions below and change the settings of your web browser so that it is not possible to store cookies and then use them.

What are cookies and what are they used for

Cookies are text files that contain information that is stored in the web browser of your computer, mobile phone or tablet (device) when you visit our website. Cookies are then sent back each time you visit this or any other website that recognizes these cookies.

Cookies are very useful and have many functions. They allow websites to recognize a device, which will let them know if the device has visited the site before. They also allow you to remember your visitor's preferences, understand how the website is used, and help improve the overall user experience. Cookies also help ensure that the online advertising that website visitors see is more relevant to them.

What cookies do we use?

We use the following types of cookies on the website:

Necessary cookies - These cookies are needed to browse our websites, services, applications and their individual elements. Without them, it is not possible to provide services such as a shopping cart, saved search and the like.

Functional cookies - These cookies allow the website to remember your preferences, interests or past items that you have chosen while browsing, or even your geographical location. We can thus adapt our website to you and provide it with a better presentation. For example, based on your geographical location, we may provide you with a website in your language, and based on the products or videos you have viewed, we may be able to offer you other similar products or videos. These cookies do not personally identify you.

Analytical / performance cookies - These cookies collect information about how you use our website, such as whether you have viewed certain content or which pages you visit most often. Thanks to this data, we can optimize the website and simplify it. All data that these cookies collect is in aggregate form, ie anonymous. They do not identify you personally in any way.

How to delete and prevent the use of cookies

Analytics cookies can also be enabled, disabled or deleted in your web browser. Follow the instructions in your browser to do this. Disabling cookies does not delete them, you must do so separately.
